

Studying for your degree is an investment in your future, and we understand that financing your studies requires important decisions.

All students who apply through this partnership will receive an exclusive scholarship. The UOB-HKUST Strategic Partner Scholarship will reduce your tuition fee by 10%.

You do not need to apply for the scholarship; it will be awarded when you apply. However, if you apply using an agent, you won't be eligible for a scholarship.

Tuition fees will rise by a small amount each year to account for inflation. You should budget for an annual increase of 8%.

Global Transfer Bursary

The Global Transfer Bursary is exclusive for students from our partner institutions who apply via the Global Transfer Programme. The award is to be used towards living costs to support you as you study.

Think Big Scholarships

Our Think Big Scholarship Programme offers a range of scholarships, exclusive to international students, that can help fund your tuition fees.

How to apply

To apply for the bursary or scholarships, you need to already have applied to study at the University of Bristol via the Global Transfer Programme. Find out how to submit your application on our website: bristol.ac.uk/international/partnerships/apply

Please note, you only need to submit one application. You will then be considered for all funding you are eligible for.



Think Big Development Programme

As well as receiving financial support, Think Big scholarship winners have the opportunity to take part in the Think Big Development Programme. Exclusive to University of Bristol scholars, the programme aims to increase your confidence and employability, giving you the springboard you need to fulfil your potential and excel in your chosen field.



You are only able to receive one scholarship/fee discount. If you are shortlisted for more than one scholarship/fee discount, you will automatically be awarded the higher amount.



Entry requirements

To transfer to Bristol, you must meet the academic and English language requirements.

You do not need to have met these requirements when you apply.

You will need to provide evidence that you have reached the required English language level and our academic requirements when you apply for your UK visa. You will normally apply for your visa in July.

If you are struggling to meet our English language requirements you can complete our Pre-Sessional Programme. This allows students to spend their summer improving their English language and academic skills before starting their degree at Bristol.
