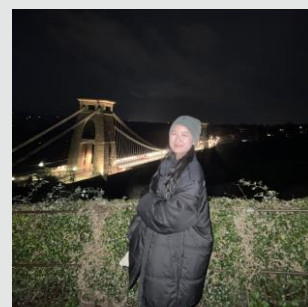

Tuition fees

Studying for your degree is an investment in your future, and we understand that financing your studies requires important decisions.

All students who apply through this partnership will receive an exclusive scholarship. The UOB-HKUST Strategic Partner Scholarship will reduce your tuition fee by 10%.

You do not need to apply for the scholarship, it will be awarded when you apply. However, if you apply using an agent, you won't be eligible for a scholarship.

Your tuition fees

Tuition fees will rise by a small amount each year to account for inflation. You should budget for an annual increase of 8%.



Entry requirements

To transfer to Bristol, you must meet the academic and English language requirements.

Academic

CGPA requirements <i>You must achieve a minimum of the following grade/CGPA in order to transfer</i>	3.0
Mandatory optional units / required study plan <i>You must study the following units at your current institution</i>	They must have successfully completed at least one course from each of the following groups: Group A: • LIFS 2240 Cell Biology Laboratory, OR • LIFS 2720 Biochemistry Laboratory, OR • LIFS 3110 Biotechnological Application of Recombinant DNA Techniques, OR • LIFS 3370 Human Genetics in Practice Group B: • LIFS 3140 General Genetics, OR • LIFS 4370 Human Genetics and Personalized Medicine Group C: • LIFS 4961 OR LIFS 4971 & 4981 Biochemistry & Cell Biology Capstone or Research Projects, OR • LIFS 4963 OR LIFS 4973 & 4983 Biotechnology Capstone or Research Projects <i>Note: These requirements apply to all applicants except those enrolled in the BSc in Biomedical and Health Sciences, who are not restricted to these specified units.</i>
Additional entry requirements <i>You must meet the following additional requirements to be eligible to transfer.</i>	You must complete the Supplementary Assessment Questionnaire (SAQ) as part of the admissions process. The SAQ aims to assess your understanding of the course and profession you are hoping to join, as well as highlight personal attributes which make you suited to the programme.

English language

Because of our partnership agreement, by completing your degree from Hong Kong University of Science and Technology (HKUST) you will have automatically met our English language requirements. You will therefore not need to provide any English language qualifications.



You do not need to have met the academic requirements when you apply.

You will need to provide evidence that you have reached the required academic requirements when you apply for your UK visa. You will normally apply for your visa in July.
